Site rules

Parents are requested to keep children from the play area before 9:00 am. Young children should be accompanied by an adult in the play area.

Please do not drive cars over the grass and keep to the 5 m.p.h. speed limit.

Young children must be accompanied by an adult, and are not allowed to play in the toilets.

Swimming pool rules

In keeping with H.S.E. recommendations

These rules are for the safety and enjoyment of all who use the pool. The pool is open from the Spring Bank Holiday until the 2nd week in September, subject to weather conditions. Opening times vary please see notice by pool gate.

Water is dangerous

1. No diving
2. No running
3. No inflatables
4. No bombing
5. No acrobatics
6. No unruly behaviour
7. Children under the age of 15 must be supervised (H.S.E. recommendation) when using the pool by a responsible adult (a person over 18).
8. No T-shirts to be worn in the water (it clogs the filter, and the chlorine will bleach the T-shirt).
9. Ball games are only allowed if no one else is in the pool.
10. No flippers, flippers may rip the liner.
11. Please keep the gate to the pool closed.
12. No-one is allowed in the poolside area when the pool is closed.
13. The maximum pool load is 32 persons, please do not exceed this number.
14. No bottles or glasses allowed on pool side.
15. Please shower before using pool.
16. Please use the toilet before entering the pool.
17. Do not swim alone.

Anyone not conforming with the above rules will be asked to leave the pool.

Emergency procedure

In the case of an emergency.

1. Raise the alarm by pushing button (pool alarm) located by pump room, please ensure you are familiar with the location of the alarm, a member of staff will arrive at the pool as soon as possible.
2. Clear the pool area of all members of the public.
3. The nearest phone is at the bungalow.
4. Dealing with any casualty should only be undertaken by a competent person. If unsure wait for staff to arrive.
